Road to Recovery is an American Cancer Society service that provides free transportation for cancer patients to their treatments and home again. Transportation is provided according to the needs and available resources in the community, and is available for cancer patients that cannot drive themselves to treatment, that do not have insurance to cover transportation services or that do not have family members or friends that can help with a ride. Some exceptions can be made in special situations. Road to Recovery transportation is provided by trained volunteers who use their own vehicles to give this service. Patients must be ambulatory.

Please call at least a week before ride is needed (the more advance notice the better)

NOTE: The office to contact is located in Topsham but service is provided in York and Cumberland county as well. The Amtrak Downeaster has partnered with the American Cancer Society to offer a significant discount to cancer patients for medical travel to Boston. The offer is valid on all trains Monday-Friday. Travel must originate in Maine and terminate in Woburn or Boston ONLY. To access this service patients or medical providers MUST contact the American Cancer Society. Patient (and one companion if desired) can travel for \$12 one-way, \$24 round trip per person.

Please see brochure at weblink or call for details about routes. There is a regular bus route between Springvale and South Sanford. The WAVE transports riders to training and job sites, and their children to day care.
A Volunteer Driver program transports clients of DHHS, elderly persons at risk and those with mental health needs to medical appointments. Currently there is funding to assist low income persons with 1 trip/month to medical appointments if they have no other options.
