- More and more Medicare Advantage Plans are offering dental benefits. Call your insurance company to see if they provide any benefits (the telephone number is on the back of your card).
- People 21 and over with full MaineCare have access to comprehensive dental coverage. For more information or to find a provider, call MaineCare Member Services on 1.800.977.6740.
- If you are a Veteran, you may be eligible for benefits. Check with the VA Regional office by calling 1.800.827.1000.
- Does your dentist offer any payment plans or sliding fee scales? Does your dentist offer a senior discount?
