

Low-No Cost Home Repair Program



Habitat for Humanity of Greater Portland's Critical Home Repair Program provides high quality, affordable home repairs to low-income families and seniors. Repairs aim to address serious health and safety concerns to homes that are:

- Located in Cumberland County, excluding Brunswick, Harpswell, and the islands.
- Owner-occupied
- Have qualifying household income and home value

Repairs may include, but are not limited to:

- **Roof Repairs and Replacements:** Fixing leaks and damage
- **Plumbing and electrical work:** To ensure safety and functionality
- **Accessibility modifications:** Replacement of steps, decks, showers/tubs, doors, and other systems that impede mobility
- **And more:** Grab bars and railings, repairs to failing floor systems, siding, and more

Cost of Repair:

Income verification required. Payment for services will be required on a sliding scale based upon the household's income and the cost of material used to complete repairs.
